Annexure

Responsibilities

The squad shall be responsible to maintain necessary vigil, oversight and patrolling functions and shall remain mobile, alert and active at all times.

It shall be called upon to make surprise raids on hostel and other places vulnerable to incidents of, and having the potential of ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.

It shall also conduct on the spot enquiry into any incidence of ragging referred to it by Head of the Institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be; and submit the enquiry report along with recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action.

The squad shall conduct such enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and the principles of natural justice and after giving adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incident of ragging, and considering such other relevant information as may be required.
